



Day 1 – Thursday – May 9: Flight

Overnight flight from USA to Tel-Aviv.

Day 2 - Friday - May 10: Arrival - Nazareth - Tiberias

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion airport, you will be met and assisted by a Coral Travel & Tours representative at the airport. Meet your guide and drive north. If time permits stop at **Mt. Precipice** for an overview of **Nazareth**, the home of Joseph and Mary. Stop at **Nazareth Village** where you will learn about the life in ancient days. Then, on your way to Tiberias, pass **Cana of Galilee**, where Jesus performed his first miracle (John 2: 1-11): turning jars of water into wine. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 3 - Saturday - May 11: Around the Sea of Galilee


The day starts with a **boat ride** on the Sea of Galilee. Then, visit the **Mount of Beatitudes**, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5:1-12). Continue on to **Capernaum**, the town Jesus made his home after leaving Nazareth. Capernaum is the place where Jesus recruited the first of His disciples (Matthew 4:13, Luke 4:31-37, Matthew 8:14-17, Mark 2:1-12, Matthew 8:5-13, Mark 5:21-43, Matthew 11:23-24). Visit the excavation of the ancient synagogue and the house of St. Peter. You will also visit **Tabgha**, the site of the miracle with the swine. Visit **Bethsaida**, **Mensa Christi Church** and **Chorazim**. Your last stop today will be **Magdala**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 4 - Sunday - May 12: Golan Heights - Jordan River

In the morning drive to **Tel Dan**, an important biblical city and a breathtaking nature reserve. The bible mentions the city few times. It is here that Peter made his confession of faith in Jesus (Matthew 16:13):" From Dan to Beer Sheba". Continue to the **Banias**, site of the ancient **Caesarea Philippi**. Stop at **Mt. Bental**. End the day at the **Jordan River** with an opportunity to be baptized (optional). Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 5 - Monday - May 13: Megiddo - Mt. Carmel - Shiloh - Dead Sea

After breakfast leave the Sea of Galilee and drive to **Megiddo**, the fortress city of King Solomon, later built upon by King Ahab. Continue to **Mt. Carmel**, to the "**Mukhraka**," the site where Elijah challenged and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal (King 18:20). Continue to **Shiloh**. Lunch will be at **Temptation Restaurant**. Pass **Jericho**, believed to be the world's oldest walled city. This was the first city taken by Joshua when the Hebrews returned from Egypt – 'and the walls fell down'. It was also the site of the Mount of Temptation (Mark 1:13). End the day at your hotel located on the Shore of the Dead Sea. Dinner and overnight: Hotel at the Dead Sea.



Day 6 - Tuesday - May 14: Massada - - Ein Gedi - Genesis Land - Bethlehem

After breakfast depart your hotel at the Dead Sea and drive to Massada. Ascend Massada by cable car. Massada is the site of the most dramatic act in Jewish History. Explore the ancient excavation of Herod's Palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the Ramp, and the oldest Synagogue in the world. Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to Ein Gedi, an Oasis on the Dead Sea shore. Near the 200-meter-high waterfall is a cave where David had his famous meeting with King Saul (First Samuel 24: 1-23). A walk around the reservation confirms that Ein Gedi is one of the most beautiful reservations in the world. On your way to Jerusalem stop at Abraham's Tent (Genesis Land) for Abraham hospitality a camel ride and lunch. Drive to Bethlehem and visit the Church of Nativity and Shepherds' Field. Drive to Jerusalem. Enter the city of Jerusalem in the traditional way and view the city from Mt. Scopus. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 7 - Wednesday - May 15: Jerusalem

The day starts with an early visit to the **Temple Mount**. Then visit the **Southern Steps** and wall excavations. Visit the **Western Wall** and the **Rabbinical Tunnel**. Continue to the **Temple Institute**. Then you will visit **St. Anne's Church**, which is a fine example of Crusader architecture and the **Pools of Bethesda**. Time to shop in the **Old City**. Visit the **City of David** where you will visit **Jeremiah's Cistern** and the **Pool of Siloam**. Visit the **Israel Museum**, where the **Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed** and the **Holy Land walk-around model** of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the Second Temple period. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 8 – Thursday – May 16: Jerusalem

This morning ascend the **Mount of Olives** (Matthew 24:3, Luke 21:37) for a breathtaking panoramic view of the old city of Jerusalem. Walk along the **Palm Sunday Way** to the **Garden of Gethsemane** (Matthew 26:36-46, Luke 22:39-45, Mark 14:32-42) where Jesus spent the last night before he was arrested. Visit the **Church of All Nations**. Drive along the "last way" to Mt. Zion. Cross the Kidron Valley and see the Tombs of Absalom, Zachary and James. Visit the **House of the High Priest Caiphas** and the **Church of Peter in Gallicantu** (Matthew 26:31-35). This is the place where Peter denied the Lord 3 times. Visit the **Last Supper Room** (Matthew 26:17-25) and **King David's Tomb**. In the Old City you will also visit the **Holy Sepulchre Church**. End the day with communion at the **Garden Tomb**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 9 - Friday - May 17: Tel Maresha - Caesarea

You will spend the day out of Jerusalem. Start at **Tel Maresha** and participate in an Archeologic dig. Then drive north and visit **Caesarea**. Caesarea was the seat of the Roman Procurator of the Judea in the time of Christ and the place St. Peter converted the centurion Cornelius (Acts 10:24). Explore the Roman Theater and the aqueduct and view the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times. Return to Jerusalem. In the late afternoon attend a **Candlelight Service** and **Farewell dinner**. Overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 10 - Saturday - May 18: Tel Aviv - USA

Transfer to the airport for your flight back to the USA. Arrive the same day.
