THE PLANNED ITINERARY FOR THE HOLY LAND

Day 1- Overnight flight to Tel Aviv, Israel.

Day 2 — Arrival in the Premised Land — Jaffa — Tel Aviv — Shores of the Mediterranean

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel-Aviv.
