

Day 1 – March 1 - Sunday: USA – Tel Aviv Overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 - March 2 - Monday: Ben Gurion Airport, Tel-Aviv - Netanya


Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel-Aviv where your Coral representative will be waiting to greet and assist you. Meet your guide and drive along the **Plains of the Sharon** to Netanya. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Netanya.

Day 3 - March 3 - Tuesday: Caesarea - Mt. Carmel - Megiddo - Sea of Galilee

This morning drive to the ancient city of Caesarea, the seat of the Roman Procurator of Judea at the time of the Christ, and the site where Peter converted the centurion Cornelius. This fortified harbor city was built 2000 years ago by King Herod the Great. View the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times. Explore the Roman Theater and the Aqueducts. Continue to Mt. Carmel, to the "Mukhraka," the site where Elijah challenged and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal (King 18:20). Journey through the heartland of Israel to Megiddo, the fortress city of King Solomon, later built upon by King Ahab. The books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we study about the final Battle of Armageddon (Revelation 16: 14-19). Drive by Nazareth, the home of Joseph and Mary and by the city of Cana of Galilee, where Jesus performed his first miracle (John 2: 1-11): turning jars of water into wine. Stop at Mt. Arbel for an overlook on the Sea of Galilee. Drive to Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 4 - March 4 - Wednesday: Magdala - Tel Dan - Caesarea Philippe - Golan Heights - Around the Sea of Galilee

Your first stop today will be at the synagogue of **Magdala**. Drive to **Tel Dan**, an important biblical city and a breathtaking Nature Reserve. The bible mentions the city a few times: "From Dan to Beer Sheba," indicating the full length of the kingdom of Israel. Continue to the **Banias**, site of the ancient **Caesarea Philippi**. It is here that Peter made his confession of faith in Jesus (Matthew 16:13). View the waterfall. After a short ride through the **Golan Heights** return to the Sea of Galilee and visit the **Mount of Beatitudes**, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5:1-12). Continue to **Capernaum**, the town where Messiah ministered and drew His Disciples (Matthew 4:13). Visit the excavation of the House of the Apostle Peter and the Ancient Synagogue. End the day with a **boat ride** on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.



Day 5 - March 5 - Thursday: Beit Shean - Jordan Valley - Jerusalem

After breakfast leave the Sea of Galilee and drive to **Bet She'an** where recent excavations have disclosed the impressive ruins of the country's largest city in the Roman and Byzantine periods which was destroyed by an earthquake in 749 CE. The tour continues through the **Jordan Valley** past **Jericho**, believed to be the world's oldest walled city. This was the first city taken by Joshua when the Hebrews returned from Egypt – 'and the walls fell down.' It was also the site of the Mount of Temptation (Mark 1:13). Stop at **Kasser El Yahud** (the immersion site) and take time for a brief **Mikveh**. Drive to **Jerusalem**. Enter the city of Jerusalem in the traditional way and view the city from the **Mt. of Olives** (Matthew 24:3, Luke 21:37) for a breathtaking panoramic view of the old city of Jerusalem. Walk to the **Garden of Gethsemane** (Matthew 26:36-46, Luke 22:39-45, Mark 14:32-42) where Jesus spent the last night before he was arrested. Drive along the "last way" to **Mt. Zion**. Cross the Kidron Valley and see the Tombs of Absalom, Zachary and James. Visit the **House of the High Priest Caiphas**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 6 - March 6 - Friday: Jerusalem

Free day. Visit the Kotel (Western Wall) to welcome the Shabbat. Return to your hotel. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 7 - March 7 - Saturday: Jerusalem

Free day. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 8 - March 8 - Sunday: Massada - Ein Gedi - Qumran - Dead Sea

After breakfast depart from Jerusalem to the Dead Sea and visit **Massada**. Ascend Massada by cable car. Massada is the site of the most dramatic act in Jewish History. Explore the ancient excavation of Herod's Palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the Ramp, and the oldest Synagogue in the world. Continue to **Ein Gedi**, an Oasis on the Dead Sea shore. Near the 200 meter high waterfall is a cave where David had his famous meeting with King Saul (First Samuel 24: 1-23). A walk around the reservation confirms that Ein Gedi is one of the most beautiful reservations in the world. Visit **Qumran**, where the 2000 years old Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Continue to the Dead Sea shore for an afternoon "float" on the sea. Return to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 9 - March 9 - Monday: Shiloh - Hebron - Mt. Grizim - Mt. Ebal

This morning you will drive out of Jerusalem and visit **Hebron, Shiloh** (include the Shiloh Children's Center), **Mt. Grizim & Mt. Ebal.** Return to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 10 - March 10 - Tuesday: Jerusalem

After breakfast drive to Mt. Zion and visit the City of David & Hezekiah's Tunnel. Enter the Old City of Jerusalem and visit the Davidson Center (Southern Wall excavations), the Western Wall Tunnel and the Temple Institute. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.


Day 11 - March 11 - Wednesday: Jerusalem

After breakfast visit the **Menorah** at the Knesset (Israel Parliament). Visit the **Israel Museum**, the **Shrine of the Book** (where some of the Dead Sea Scrolls and Bar Kokhva letters are exhibited) and the Holy Land Model. Continue to **Yad Vashem**, the Holocaust Museum. **Farewell dinner**. Overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem .

Day 12 - March 12 - Thursday - February 28: Jerusalem

Transfer to the airport for your flight back to the USA. Arrive the same day.
