Day 1 – October 27 - Monday: USA – Tel Aviv

Overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 – October 28 - Tuesday: Tel Aviv

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel-Aviv. You will be met and assisted by a Coral Travel & Tours representative inside the terminal. Visit **Jaffa**, one of the oldest cities in the world. Visit the House of Simon the Tanner, and walk through Jaffa's reconstructed Old Quarter. Transfer to your hotel in Tel-Aviv. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tel Aviv.

Day 3 – October 29 - Wednesday: Caesarea – Megiddo – Sea of Galilee

Depart Tel Aviv, Israel's modern metropolis, travel through the Sharon plain to **Caesarea**, the seat of the Roman Procurator of Judea at the time of the Christ, and the site where Peter converted the centurion, Cornelius. This fortified harbor city was built 2000 years ago by King Herod the Great. View the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times. Explore the Roman Theater and the Aqueducts. A drive-up **Mt. Carmel** will bring us to the site where Elijah challenged and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal. Continue to **Megiddo**, the Fortress City of King Solomon, later built again by King Ahab. The books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we study about the final Battle of Armageddon, while viewing the Plains of Jezreel. On your way to Tiberias drive through **Nazareth**, the home of Joseph and Mary and through the city of **Cana of Galilee**, where Jesus performed his first miracle (John 2: 1-11): turning jars of water into wine. Drive to Tiberias. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 4 – October 30 - Thursday: Sea of Galilee

The day starts with a drive to the **Mt. of Beatitudes**, site of the Sermon on the Mount. Drive along the Hula Valley to **Tel Dan** and visit the remains of the city. Via a ride through the Golan Heights, we return to the northern shore of the Sea of Galilee, the area where Jesus spent his years of ministry. See the ruins of **Capernaum**, the town where Jesus made his home after leaving Nazareth. After a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee drive to **Tabgha** where the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes took place. End the day with a visit to **Kibbutz Ginnosar** and visit the "**Jesus Boat**." Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 5 – October 31 - Friday: Beit Shean - Jordan Valley - Jerusalem

This morning you will have an opportunity to be baptized. Then, depart the Sea of Galilee and drive to **Bet She'an**. Recent excavations there have disclosed the impressive ruins of the country's largest city in the Roman and Byzantine periods, which was destroyed by an earthquake in 749 CE. Drive to **Bet Alfa** and see the

ancient Synagogue. Visit **Ein Harod**, the site of Judge Gideon (Judges 7: 1-25). The tour continues through the **Jordan Valley** past Jericho, believed to be the world's oldest walled city. This was the first city taken by Joshua when the Hebrews returned from Egypt – 'and the walls fell down'. It was also the site of the **Mount of Temptation**. (Mark 1:13). Drive to Jerusalem. Pass the traditional site of the Inn of the Good Samaritan. Enter the city of **Jerusalem** in the traditional way and view the city from **Mt. of Scopus**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 6 – November 1 - Saturday: Jerusalem

In the morning ascend the **Mount of Olives** for a breathtaking panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem. Walk along the **Palm Sunday Way** and descend to the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus spent the last night before he was arrested. Visit the famous **Church of All Nations**. Walk along the "**last way**" to Mt. Zion. Stand next to the Southern Wall and view the City of David. Visit the **Church of Peter in Gallicantu**, the site where Peter denied his Lord three times. It was also the **House of the High Priest Caiphas** where Jesus was interrogated. Today you will also visit the **Last Supper Room** on **Mt. Zion** and **King David's Tomb**. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 7 – November 2 - Sunday: Dead Sea – Qumran – Massada – Ein Gedi

After breakfast depart from Jerusalem to the Dead Sea and visit **Massada**. Ascend Massada by cable car. Massada is the site of the most dramatic act in Jewish History. Explore the ancient excavation of Herod's Palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the Ramp, and the oldest Synagogue in the world. Continue to **Ein Gedi**, an Oasis on the Dead Sea shore. Near the 200-meter-high waterfall is a cave where David had his famous meeting with King Saul (First Samuel 24: 1-23). The Walk around the reservation confirms that Ein Gedi is one of the most beautiful reservations in the world. Visit **Qumran**, where the 2000 years old Dead Sea Scrolls were found. In the afternoon "float" on the **Dead Sea**. Return to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 – November 3 – Monday: Jerusalem

This morning walk up to the **Temple Mount** site and see the **Dome of the Rock and El Aqza Mosque**). Continue to the **Pool of Bethesda**, and **St. Anne's Church**, a fine example of Crusader architecture. Visit the **Western Wall**, last remnant of the second Jewish Temple during the time of Jesus. Then, visit the **Southern Wall excavations** (Davidson Center) and the **Western Wall Tunnel**. End your visit at the **City of David**, **Pool of Siloam** and **Hezekiah Tunnel**. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 – November 4 - Tuesday: Jerusalem

On the western side of the city visit **Yad Vashem** the National Holocaust Museum. Drive through the Knesset (Israeli Parliament) and visit the famous Menorah (the official sign of the State of Israel). Proceed to the **Israel Museum** to see the **Holy Land walk-around model** of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the Second Temple period (the time of Jesus) and the **Shrine of the Book** where the Dead Sea Scrolls are kept. Visit Golgotha and then end your visit at the **Garden Tomb** attend a tour and service. **Farewell dinner**. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10 – November 5 - Wednesday: Jerusalem – Tel Aviv - USA

Transfer from Jerusalem hotel to the Airport for departure. Arrive in USA the same day.

Deposits and Payments:

\$350.00 deposit is required by each traveler with their reservation form no later than **June 27, 2025** to guarantee booking. The balance is due 60 days prior to departure (**August 27, 2025**). Prices are discounted for payment by cash, check or money order. Credit card payments are subject to a 3% additional fee.

Cancellation Penalties: All cancellations must be in writing

- Up to 100 days prior to departure date \$75.00 cancellation fee
- From 99-61 days prior to departure date \$250.00 cancellation fee
- From 60-46 days prior to departure date \$350.00 cancellation fee
- From 45 days prior to departure date and on – full cancellation fee (100%)

Passports: You will be required to provide Coral Travel & Tours with a copy of your passport with final payment. Please Note: The State of Israel requires that your passport have an expiration date not less than 6 months after your date of arrival in Israel (**April 27, 2026**).

Fuel Surcharge note: Please note that in this period of escalating fuel prices, we have been advised by the airlines that they may be adding fuel surcharges prior to travel. If this occurs, these charges will be passed on to each traveler.
