Day 1 – April 27 - Thursday: USA - Tel - Aviv Overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 – April 28 - Friday: Arrival – Caesarea – Megiddo – Sea of Galilee
Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel-Aviv where a Coral representative will be
waiting to greet and assist you. Meet your quide and, travel through the Sharon


waiting to greet and assist you. Meet your guide and travel through the Sharon plain to Caesarea, the seat of the Roman Procurator of Judea at the time of Christ, and the site where Peter converted the centurion Cornelius. This fortified harbor city was built 2000 years ago by King Herod the Great. View the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times. Explore the Roman Theater and the Aqueducts. A drive up Mt. Carmel will bring us to the site where Elijah challenged and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal. Continue to Megiddo, the Fortress City of King Solomon, later built again by King Ahab. The books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we study about the final Battle of Armageddon end the day at Sachne. On your way to Tiberias pass Cana of Galilee. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.(Nof Ginossar)

Day 3 - April 29 - Saturday: Sea of Galilee - Golan Heights

The day will start with a **boat ride** on the Sea of Galilee. Continue to Kibbutz' Ginossar and visit the **"ancient boat"** believed to be from the time of Jesus. Continue on to **Hazor**. Drive to **Tel Dan**, an important biblical city and a breath-taking nature reserve. The bible mentions the city few times: "From Dan to Beer Sheba". Continue to the Banias, site of the ancient **Caesarea Philippe**. It is here that Peter made his confession of faith in Jesus (Matthew 16:13). Enjoy a panoramic view of the Golan Heights from **Mt**. **Bental**. In the afternoon visit **Nazareth Village**. Return to Tiberias. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias. (Nof Ginnosar)

Day 4 - April 30 - Sunday: Sea of Galilee

This morning visit the **Mount of Beatitudes**, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5:1-12). Continue to **Tabgha**. Visit **Capernaum**, the town Jesus made his home after leaving Nazareth. Capernaum is the place where Jesus recruited the first of His disciples (Matthew 4:13, Luke 4:31-37, Matthew 8:14-17, Mark 2:1-12, Matthew 8:5-13, Mark 5:21-43, Matthew 11:23-24). Visit the excavation of the ancient synagogue and the house of St. Peter. Visit the newly dug site of **Bethsaida**, which, according to scripture, is the site of the feeding of the 5000. Continue on to **Kursi**, the site of the miracle with the swine. We'll end the day at the **Jordan River** with an opportunity to be **baptized** (**optional**). Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.(Nof Ginnosar)



Day 5 - May 1 - Monday: Bet She'an - Gideon Spring - Qumran

After breakfast leave Tiberias and drive to Bet She'an. Recent excavations have unveiled the impressive ruins of the country's largest city in the Roman and Byzantine periods, which was destroyed by an earthquake in 749 AD. Drive through the Jordan Valley and stop at the War Monument of the Jordan Valley (at the Junction of Ma'ale Ephraim) overlooking the Gilgal, the crossing point of the Israelites to the Promised Land. Continue along the Jordan Valley past Jericho, believed to be the world's oldest walled city. This was the first city taken by Joshua when the Hebrews returned from Egypt —"and the walls fell down"- and was also the site of the Mt. of Temptation. . Continue Drive to Jerusalem and enter the city as a pilgrim. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 6 - May 2 - Tuesday: Jerusalem - Bet Shemesh - Ella Valley

Today is Independence Day! Spend the morning out of Jerusalem visiting **Bet Shemesh**, **Zorah** in the Soreck Valley and the **Ella Valley**. Return to Jerusalem. Ascend the **Mount of Olives** for a breathtaking panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem. Walk along **the Palm Sunday Way** and descend to the **Garden of Gethsemane**, where Jesus spent the last night before he was arrested. Drive along **the Kidron Valley** and see the **Tombs of Absalom Zachary and James**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 7 - May 3 - Wednesday: Jerusalem

After breakfast drive to Mt. Moriah. Visit the Western Wall, last remnant of the second Jewish Temple during the time of Jesus. Walk up to the Temple site and view the Dome of the Rock and El Aqsa Mosque. Visit the Cardo (the Jewish Quarter) and the Davidson Center (Southern Wall excavation). Stand next to the excavation of the City. Continue to the City of David and Hezekiah's Tunnel. Walk to the Pool of Bethesda and St. Anne's Church, a fine example of Crusader architecture. End your day with a visit to the Rabbinical Tunnel. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 8 May 4 - Thursday: Jerusalem

This morning drive to the western side of the city. Stand next to the **Menorah**, across from the Knesset (Israeli parliament). Then, visit **Yad Vashem**, the Holocaust Memorial, a visit you will never forget. Continue to the **Israel Museum**, where **the Dead Sea Scrolls** are displayed and the **Holy Land walk-around model** of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the Second Temple period. In the afternoon partake in the **archeological sifting** of the remains of the Temple Mount ("Emek Zurim"). Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 9 - May 5 - Friday: Ein Gedi - Massada - Qumran - Jerusalem

After an early breakfast travel along the shore of the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth to Massada. Ascend Massada by cable car. Massada is the site of the most dramatic act in Jewish history. Explore the ancient excavation of Herod's Palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the ramp and the oldest synagogue in the world. Continue to Ein Gedi, the desert oasis where David hid from Saul, visit the oasis and hike to the waterfall. Drive to Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls where found. Enjoy an afternoon "float" on the Dead Sea. Return to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 10 - May 6 - Saturday: Jerusalem

Free morning. Communion at the Garden Tomb. Farewell dinner. Overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 11 - May 7 - Sunday: Tel Aviv - USA

After breakfast transfer to the airport for your flight back to the USA. Arrive the same day.
