Day 1 - Friday - December 2: USA - Tel Day 4 - Monday - December 5: Tel Dan -Aviv

Overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 - Saturday - December 3: Arrival -Jaffa - Tel Aviv

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel-Aviv. You will be met and assisted by a Coral Travel & Tours representative inside the terminal. Meet your guide and driver and drive to Jaffa, one of the oldest cities in the Visit the House of Simon the Tanner, and walk through Jaffa's reconstructed Old Quarter. Transfer to your hotel in Tel-Aviv. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tel Aviv.

Day 3 - Sunday - December 4: Caesarea - Megiddo - Sea of Galilee


This morning, after a short drive through Tel Aviv, Israel's modern metropolis, travel through the Sharon plain to Caesarea, the seat of the Roman Procurator of Judea at the time of the Christ, and the site where Peter converted the centurion Cornelius. This fortified harbor city was built 2000 years ago by King Herod the Great. View the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times. Explore the Roman Theater and the Aqueducts. A drive up Mt. Carmel will bring us to the site where Elijah challenged and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal. Continue to Megiddo, the Fortress City of King Solomon, later built again by King Ahab. The books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we study about the final Battle of Armageddon, while viewing the miracle: turning jars of water into wine.

Caesarea Philippi - Sea of Galilee

The day starts with a drive along the Hula Valley to Tel Dan to visit the remains of the city. Continue on to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter made his confession of faith to Jesus. Stop at Mt. Bental for panoramic view. Via a ride through the Golan Heights return to the northern shore of the Sea of Galilee, the area where Jesus spent his years of ministry. See the ruins of Capernaum, the town where Jesus made his home after leaving Nazareth. View the remains of the ancient synagogue, in which he may have preached, and the house of Peter. Continue on to Tabgha where the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes took place. Drive to the Mt. of Beatitudes. site of the Sermon on the Mount. At Kibbutz Ginossar visit the "Ancient Boat" believed to be from Jesus' time. End the day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 5 - Tuesday - December 6: Bet She' an - Gideon Springs - Jerusalem

After breakfast drive to Yardenit, the baptismal site, where you will have an opportunity to be baptized (optional). Then, leave the Sea of Galilee and drive to Bet She'an. Recent excavations there have disclosed the impressive ruins of the country's largest city in the Roman and Byzantine periods, which was destroyed by an earthquake in 749 CE. Continue on to



Ein Harod, the site of Judge Gideon (Judges 7: 1-25). The tour continues through the Jordan Valley past Jericho, believed to be the world's oldest walled city. This was the first city taken by Joshua when the Hebrews returned from Egypt –' and the walls fell down'. It was also the site of the Mount of Temptation. (Mark 1:13). Drive to Jerusalem. Pass the traditional site of the Inn of the Good Samaritan. Enter the city of Jerusalem in the traditional way and view the city from Mt. Scopus. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 6 - Wednesday - December 7: Jerusalem

In the morning ascend the Mount of Olives for a breathtaking panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem. Walk along the Palm Sunday Way and descend to the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus spent the last night before he was arrested. Visit the famous Church of All Nations. Drive along the "last way" to Mt. Zion. Pass the Kidron Valley and see the Tombs of Absalom, Zachary and James. Visit the Church of Peter in Gallicantu, the site where Peter denied his Lord three times. It was also the House of the High Priest Caiphas where Jesus was interrogated. Visit the Last Supper Room and King David's Tomb. End the day with a visit to the Israel Museum, the Shrine of the Book (where some of the Dead Sea Scrolls and Bar Kokhva letters are exhibited.) and the Holy Land Model. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 7 - Thursday - December 8: Jerusalem

After breakfast drive to Mt Moriah. Visit the Western Wall, last remnant of the second Jewish Temple during the time of Jesus. Walk up to the Temple site and visit the area of the Dome of the Rock and El Aqsa Mosque. Visit the Rabbinical Tunnel. Walk to the Pools of Bethesda and St. Anne's Church, a fine example of Crusader architecture. Visit the Davidson Center (Southern Wall excavations). Drive to the western side of the city and visit Yad Vashem, the National Holocaust Museum. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 8 - Friday - December 9: Massada - Ein Gedi - Qumran

After breakfast depart from Jerusalem to the Dead Sea and visit Massada. Ascend Massada by cable car. Massada is the site of the most dramatic act in the Jewish History. Explore the ancient excavation of Herod's Palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the Ramp, and the oldest Synagogue in the world. Continue to Ein Gedi, an Oasis on the Dead Sea shore. Near the 200 meter high waterfall is a cave where David had his famous meeting with King Saul. (First Samuel 24: 1-23). A walk around the reservation confirms that Ein Gedi is one of the most beautiful reservations in the world. Visit Qumran, where the 2000 years old Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Continue to the Dead Sea shore for an afternoon "float" on the sea. Return to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 9 - Saturday - December 10: Bethlehem - Jerusalem

This morning you will visit Bethlehem, Shepherds' Fields and the Church of Nativity. Return to Jerusalem and enter the Old City. Walk along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. End your visit in Jerusalem with a service at the Garden Tomb. Farewell Dinner. Overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 10 - Sunday - December 11: Jerusalem - Tel Aviv - USA

Transfer from Jerusalem hotel to the Airport for departure. Arrive USA the same day.
