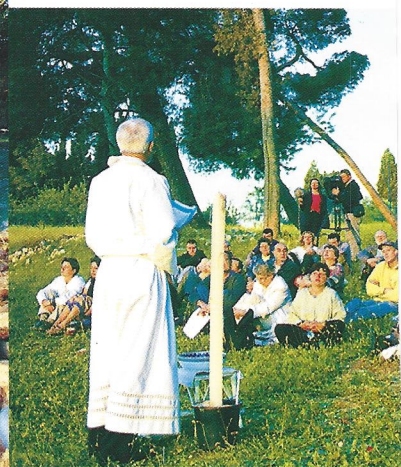
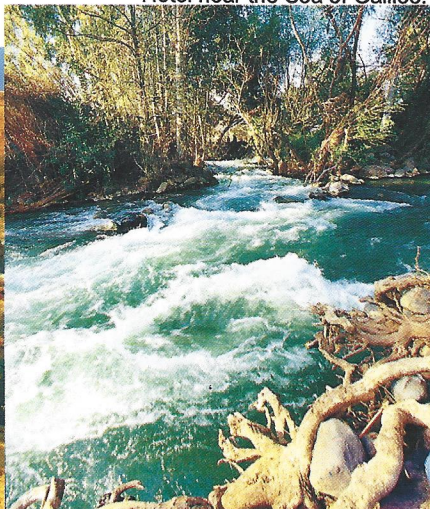
Day 1 – November 10 - Thursday: USA – Tel Aviv
Overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 – November 11 - Friday: Tel-Aviv – Jaffa – Tel Aviv
Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel-Aviv where your Coral representative will be waiting to greet and assist you. Meet your guide and drive to the ancient city of **Jaffa** where the prophet Jonah set sail for Tarshish, the apostle Peter raised Tabitha, and where Peter's vision opened up the Gospel to people from all nations. Drive by **Independence Hall** in Tel Aviv. Worship the God of Israel on the shores of the Mediterranean in a special service to usher in the Sabbath in the land of Israel. Experience the Sabbath and a Sabbath dinner in the Holy Land. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tel Aviv.

Day 3 – November 12 - Saturday: Caesarea – Mt. Carmel – Mt. Gilboah – Gideon Spring - Mt. Arbel – The Sea of Galilee

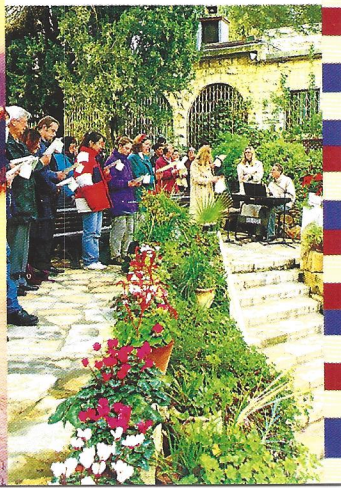
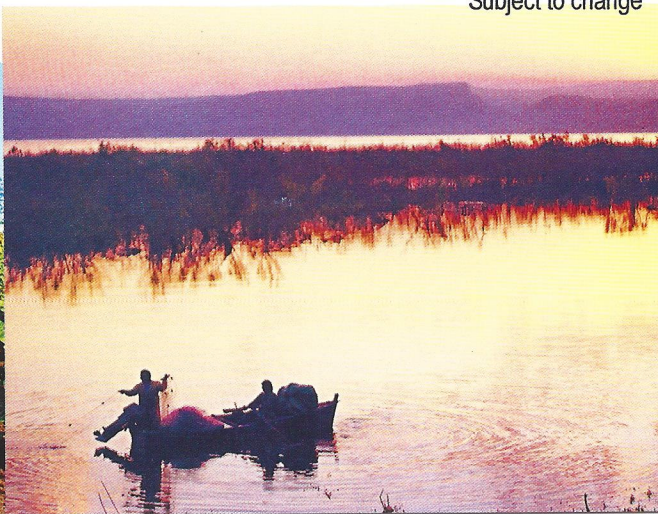
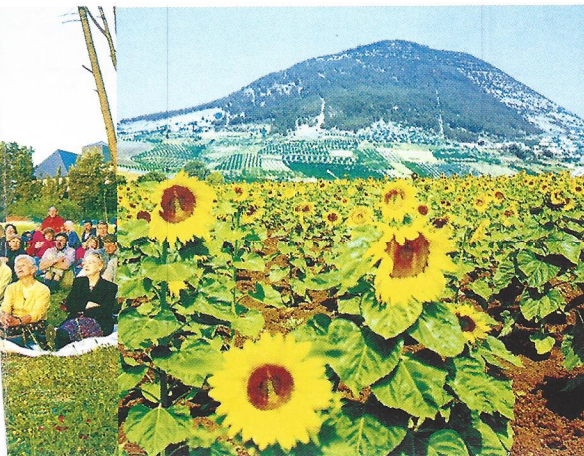
Day 10 – November 19 - Saturday: Jerusalem – departure
