Day 1 – Wednesday – January 8: USA – Tel Aviv
Overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 – Thursday – January 9: Tel Aviv – Jaffa

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel-Aviv. You will be met and assisted by a Coral Travel & Tours representative inside the terminal. Meet your guide and driver and if time permits drive to **Jaffa**, one of the oldest cities in the world. Visit the House of Simon the Tanner and a walk through Jaffa's reconstructed Old Quarter. Transfer to your hotel in Tel Aviv. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tel Aviv.

Day 3 – Friday – January 10: Caesarea – Megiddo – Sea of Galilee

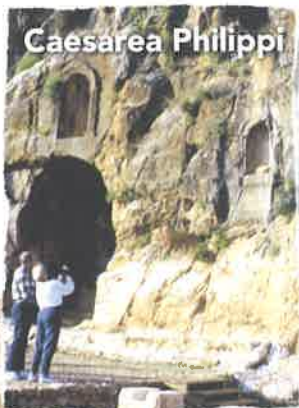
Depart Tel Aviv and travel to **Caesarea**, the seat of the Roman Procurator of Judea at the time of the Christ, and the site where Peter converted the centurion Cornelius. This fortified harbor city was built 2000 years ago by King Herod the Great. View the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times. Explore the Roman Theater and the Aqueducts. A drive up **Mt. Carmel** will bring us to the site where Elijah challenged and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal. Continue to **Megiddo**, the Fortress City of King Solomon, later built again by King Ahab. The books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we study about the final Battle of Armageddon, while viewing the Plains of Jezreel. Drive through **Nazareth**, the home of Mary and Joseph, passing Mary's Well and the Church of the Annunciation. Continue on to Tiberias via **Cana**. (Sunset from Mt Arbel if time and weather permit.) Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 4 – Saturday – January 11: Sea of Galilee

After breakfast drive to the **Mt. of Beatitudes**, site of the Sermon on the Mount, and then continue on to see the ruins of **Capernaum**, the town where Jesus made his home after leaving Nazareth. Visit the **First Century Boat Museum**. Take a **boat ride on the Sea of Galilee**. Continue to **Tabgha** where the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes took place. You will also visit **Gadera, Chorazim, Magdala and Bethsaida**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 5 – Sunday – January 12: Sea of Galilee

The day starts with a drive along the Hula Valley to **Tel Dan** to visit the remains of the city. Continue to **Caesarea Philippe**. Ride through the **Golan Heights** and stop at **Mt. Bental** for a very special panoramic view. Return to Tiberias. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 6 – Monday – January 13: Bet She'an - Jordan Valley – Jerusalem

We depart the Sea of Galilee area and drive to **Bet She'an** where recent excavations have unveiled the impressive ruins of the country's largest city in the Roman and Byzantine periods, which was destroyed by an earthquake in 749 AD. Continue to **Gideon Springs (Ein Harod)**. Drive along the **Jordan Valley** with a stop at **Qaser El Yahud**, thought to be the location where John baptized Jesus, and then up to Jerusalem passing **Jericho**, believed to be the world's oldest walled city. This was the first city taken by Joshua when the Hebrews returned from Egypt –'and the walls fell down'- and was also the site of the Mount of Temptation. Enter the city of Jerusalem in a traditional way. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 7 – Tuesday – January 14: Jerusalem

Today you will ascend the **Mount of Olives** for a breathtaking panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem. Walk along the **Palm Sunday Road** and descend to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus spent the last night before he was arrested. Visit the famous **Church of All Nations** and then back on the bus to head up **Mt Moriah** to visit the **Davidson Center**, the **Southern Steps**, and the South Wall excavations. From there you will visit **The City of David** including **Jeremiah's Cistern**, **Hezekiah's Tunnel**, and the **Pool of Siloam**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 8 – Wednesday – January 15: Massada – Ein Gedi – Qumran – Dead Sea

After breakfast depart for the Dead Sea and visit **Massada**, the site of the most dramatic act in Jewish History. Ascend by cable car. Explore the ancient excavations of Herod's palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the ramp, and the oldest synagogue in the world. Continue to **Ein Gedi**, an oasis on the Dead Sea shore, and the site where David hid from King Saul (First Samuel 24: 1-23). A walk around the park confirms that Ein Gedi is one of the most beautiful reservations in the world. Visit **Qumran**, where the 2000 years old Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Continue to the **Dead Sea** shore for an afternoon "float" on the sea. Return to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 9 – Thursday – January 16: Jerusalem - Bethlehem

Start your morning with a visit to the **Western Wall**, last remnant of the second Jewish Temple during the time of Jesus and then enter the **Rabbinical Tunnel** (the tunnel under the wall). Visit the **Burnt House**. From there you will drive to **Yad Vashem**, the National Holocaust Museum. Pass by the Knesset (Israeli Parliament) and visit the famous **Menorah** (the official sign of the State of Israel). Proceed to the **Israel Museum** to see the **Shrine of the Book** where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** are kept and the **Holy Land Model** of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the Second Temple period (the time of Jesus). In the afternoon, visit **Shepherds Fields** and **Bethlehem**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 10 – Friday – January 17: Jerusalem - Departure

Walk up onto the **Temple site** and see the area of the **Dome of the Rock** and **El Aqza Mosque**. You will then walk to the **Pool of Bethesda**, and **St. Anne's Church**, a fine example of Crusader architecture. Continue along the **Via Dolorosa** to the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**. Visit the **Last Supper Room on Mt. Zion** and **King David's Tomb**. Walk through the colorful Bazaar to the **Damascus Gate** and cross the street to view **Golgotha**. Visit the **Garden Tomb**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 11 – Saturday – January 18: Church Service – Jerusalem - Departure

After breakfast attend the **Shabbat Service at Grace and Truth Church near Ashdod (Canot)**. After services we will return to Jerusalem. **Farewell dinner**. Overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem

Day 12 – Sunday - January 19: Tel Aviv - USA

Transfer to the airport for your flight home. Arrive in USA the same day.

Deposits and Payments:

\$350.00 deposit is required by each traveler with their reservation form no later than **August 8, 2019** to guarantee booking. The balance is due 60 days prior to departure (**November 8, 2019**).

Cancellation Penalties: All cancellations must be in writing

- Up to 100 days prior to departure date \$75.00 cancellation fee
- From 99-61 days prior to departure date \$250.00 cancellation fee
- From 60-46 days prior to departure date \$350.00 cancellation fee
- From 45 days prior to departure date and on – full cancellation fee (100%)
