### **Day 1 – Wednesday – October 26: USA – Tel Aviv**

Overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

### **Day 2 – Thursday – October 27: Arrival – Jaffa – Tel Aviv**

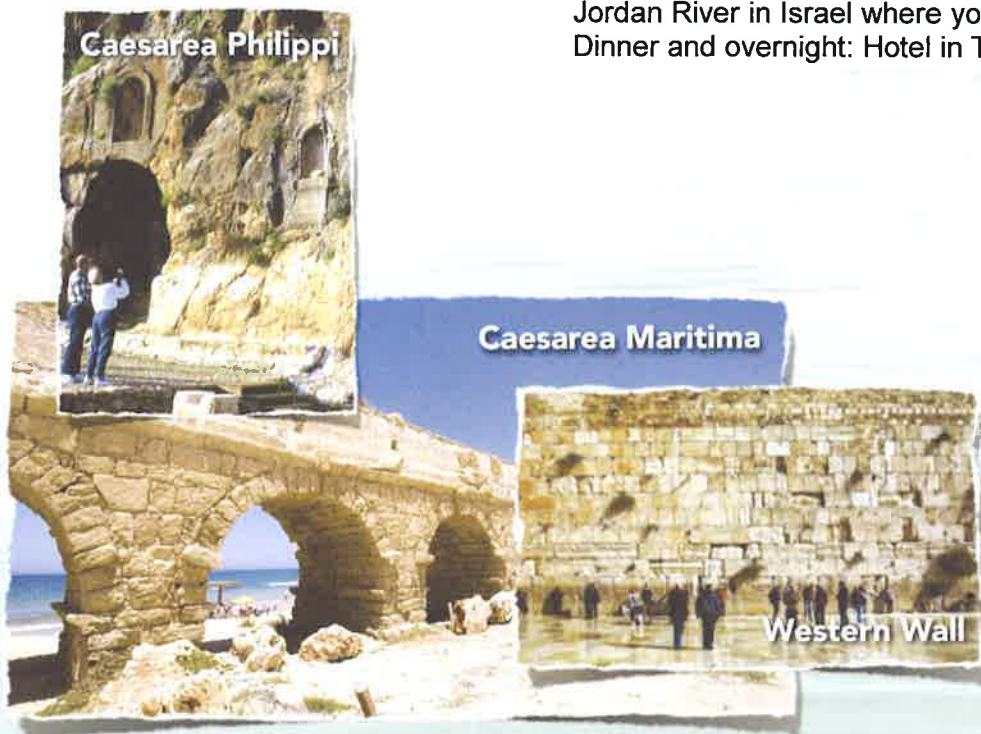
Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel Aviv. Upon arrival you will be met and assisted by a Coral Travel and Tours representative inside the terminal. Meet your guide and drive to **Jaffa**. Jaffa has been known in the bible as Joppa and is considered the world's oldest port and the place where the prophet Jonah set sail for Tarshish. Jaffa is associated with the deeds of Peter. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tel Aviv.

### **Day 3 – Friday – October 28: Caesarea – Mt. Carmel – Megiddo - Tiberias**

After breakfast, travel along the coastal road to **Caesarea**, the seat of the Roman Procurator of Judea at the time of the Christ, and the site where Peter converted the centurion Cornelius. This fortified harbor city was built 2000 years ago by King Herod the Great. View the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times. Explore the Roman Theater and the Aqueducts. A drive up **Mt. Carmel** will bring us to the site where Elijah challenged and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal. Continue on to **Megiddo**, the fortress city of King Solomon, later built upon by King Ahab. The books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we study about the final Battle of Armageddon (Revelation 16: 14-19). Continue via **Nazareth**, the home of Mary and Joseph. Pass Mary's well and the Church of the Annunciation. On your way to Tiberias you will also pass **Caná of Galilee**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

### **Day 4 – Saturday – October 29: Sea of Galilee – Golan Heights**

The day starts with a drive to the **Mt. of Beatitudes**, site of the Sermon on the Mount. Drive along the Hula Valley to **Tel Dan** and visit the remains of the city. Via a ride through the **Golan Heights** we return to the northern shore of the Sea of Galilee, the area where Jesus spent his years of ministry. See the ruins of **Capernaum**, the town where Jesus made his home after leaving Nazareth. After a **boat ride**, drive to **Tabgha** where the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fish took place. End the day at **Yardenit**, the **Baptismal Center** site on the Jordan River in Israel where you will have an opportunity to be baptized. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.





### Day 5 – Sunday – October 30: Bet She'an – Gideon Springs - Jerusalem

This morning depart Tiberias and drive to **Bet She'an** where recent excavations have unveiled the impressive ruins of the country's largest city in the Roman and Byzantine periods, which was destroyed by an earthquake in 749 AD. Continue on to **Gideon Springs**. The tour continues through the **Jordan Valley** past Jericho, believed to be the world's oldest walled city. This was the first city taken by Joshua when the Hebrews returned from Egypt – 'and the walls fell down.' It was also the site of the **Mount of Temptation** (Mark 1:13). Drive to Jerusalem. Pass the traditional site of the Inn of the Good Samaritan. Enter the city of **Jerusalem** in the traditional way and view the city from **Mt. Scopus**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

### Day 6 – Monday – October 31: Jerusalem

In the morning ascend the **Mt. of Olives** for a breathtaking panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem. Walk along the **Palm Sunday Way** and descend to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus spent the last night before he was arrested. Visit the famous **Church of All Nations**. Walk along the "last way" to **Mt. Zion**. Visit the **Church of Peter in Gallicantu**, the site where Peter denied his Lord three times. It was also the House of the **High Priest Caiaphas** where Jesus was interrogated. Visit the **Last Supper Room** on **Mt. Zion** and **King David's Tomb**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

### Day 7 – Tuesday – November - 1: Masada – Ein Gedi – Qumran – Jerusalem

After breakfast, drive to **Masada**, the site of the most dramatic act in Jewish History. Ascend by cable car. Explore the ancient excavations of Herod's palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the ramp, and the oldest synagogue in the world. Continue along the shores of the Dead Sea to **Ein Gedi**, an oasis on the Dead Sea shore and the site where David hid from King Saul (First Samuel 24: 1-23). A walk around the park confirms that Ein Gedi is one of the most beautiful reservations in the world. Visit **Qumran**, where the 2000 years old Dead Sea Scrolls were found. In the afternoon you will have the opportunity to "float" at the **Dead Sea**. Return to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

### Day 8 – Wednesday – November 2: Jerusalem

The day starts with a drive to **Mt. Moriah**. Walk up to the Temple site and see the area of the Dome of the Rock and El Aqsa Mosque. Visit the **Western Wall**, last remnant of the 2nd Jewish Temple during the time of Jesus. Continue with a visit to the **Davidson Center** (Southern Wall excavations) and the **Rabbinical Tunnel** (the tunnel under the wall). Walk to the **Pool of Bethesda**, and **St. Anne's Church**, a fine example of Crusader architecture. Continue along the **Via Dolorosa**. Walk through the colorful Bazaar to the **Jaffa Gate**. End the day with a visit to **The City of David** and **Hezekiah's Tunnel**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

### Day 9 – Thursday – November 3: Jerusalem - Departure

This morning you will visit the **Israel Museum** to see the **Shrine of the Book** where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** are kept and the **Holy Land walk-around model** of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the 2nd Temple period (the time of Jesus). Proceed to **Yad Vashem** the National Holocaust Museum. End your visit in Jerusalem with a service at the **Garden Tomb**. **Farewell dinner**. Overnight Hotel in Jerusalem.

### Day 10 – Friday - November 4: Tel Aviv - USA

Transfer to the airport for your flight back to USA. Arrive the same day.
